Abstract: *Sarcophartiopsis thyroptonthos* sp. n. is described from Costa Rica. All specimens were bred from faeces taken from young, tubular leaves of musoid plants (genera *Heliconia* and *Calathea*) used as roosts by Spix's disk-winged bat *Thyroptera tricolor* Spix. Larvae were observed in practically all roosts suggesting a highly specialized association.
